Orthodox Church Groundbreaking Tim McGeachy, CSLSG Member

This morning I attended the groundbreaking for the new St. George Orthodox Church in Washington City in the Coral Canyon Area. There were well over 100 people in attendance including the congregation and visitors. His Grace Bishop Anthony of Los Angeles (left) presided over the 30 minute ceremony, assisted by St. George Pastor Mykel Giannakakos (in black and gold) and other clergy. The special groundbreaking ceremony is performed very rarely since new Orthodox churches are rare and Father Mykel was honored to perform it.

The revered Saint George was honored during the prayer ceremony, which was performed mainly in song, as is typical in the Orthodox Church. Following the ceremony an outdoor reception was held in Highland Park on the ridge just above the site of the new church. Representatives from the architectual firm and the construction contractor were also in attendance. It was an exhuberant morning for all.
