We can develop our paradox mindset, the ability to hold multiple opposite ideas at once, and in doing so find solutions to the greatest challenges our world faces.

October 1st The Paradox Mindset

We begin our playful exploration of paradoxes with some key definitions and ideas. What is a paradox? How do we develop a paradox mindset? What is Janusian thinking and how can it support us in deepening our spirituality and growing in Science of Mind? As we dive into this subject, we find that every answer leads to more questions and that there is really no one right way to look at anything. Instead, we must open ourselves up to hold many ideas and perspectives at once and truly embrace the paradox mindset that lives within us all.


