



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### A Message from Practitioner Stephanie Starr Starrett RScP

I am the Center for Spiritual Loving (Living) and I am in St. George, UT. What do I see in that? My whole world is seen from that center. And so is yours from your own individualized Center.



THE CENTER is Whole, Perfect, Central, and available in everyone. "Spirit is at the center of everything and is always responding to our thought, there is no limit to Its manifestation for us, except the limitations that we set." ~SOM Ernest Holmes 406:2

I am in the CENTER of my circle (my world). I am like a rancher that owns horses. I learn to corral my horses, or shuffle them around from desert to grasslands and water. I see when to cut out the horses I no longer want, in order to make my herd strong, healthy and abundant, that this creates a thriving herd of horses.

I can say, like a rancher, my herds are the thoughts swirling around me. I corral them and I can set them free when I see they are not serving me. This, in rancher terms, is called culling. I do this from my center, because I desire a strong body and having a wealthy attitude. I desire being the best rancher I can be.

Why, you ask? Is it for money, or vanity, or power? Well, I say, yes...and no. So what's the point, you ask? Because, I recognize I can. Like that rancher owns horses, I own all the thoughts in my circle. I choose which ones I keep. No one nor condition (trigger) I feel, hear, touch or experience has any power over my CENTER, my CIRCLE.

Thoughts are like wild horses - they appear everywhere and can hide seemingly nowhere. They are not me, unless I claim them. Once I own them, they work for me and if they are not performing for me, seeing/feeling this, I have every right to free them.

As the owner of the horse (or thought), I don't bury it. That's absurd - who would bury a horse that isn't working, right? The same goes for thoughts. I see/feel and let go to find another beneficial one to take its place.

You are the center of your ranch, which is a circle called your world. You have the power imbued in you to make any decision about your thoughts. Circumstances are only experiences you own in your corral. You are the rancher, the CENTER of your Circle, your world.
