My process for becoming a Practitioner has taken over a decade. Early in 2013 I saw an interesting building sign while driving to my job as a high school teacher. The sign read,

“The Center for Positive Thinking.” I had been studying the teachings of Abraham through Esther Hicks for about ten years with my sweetheart, Larry. The philosophy had changed my life view from a worrisome, fearful outlook to positivity that became a natural part of me. So, in seeing that sign, my curiosity peaked. We attended a Sunday meeting there and discovered that it was the Las Vegas Center for Spiritual

Living.

We made a few visits, but Larry was receiving cancer treatment and didn't feel up to going. I felt every moment with him was precious, so we didn't return. In December, Larry left to complete his cancer journey on his own. My heart was hurting so I sought comfort within a religious community and returned to LVCSL. The more I learned about the philosophy, the more I found it harmonized with my beliefs. I wanted to know more and took advantage of the offered classes. As I continued to attend services, I admired the Practitioners speaking and praying at the meetings. Still, I had no inclination to take on the study as I was busy working as a teacher. After four years of retirement and attending a Unity church in Florida, I moved back home and found CSL St. George.

I consider myself a lifelong learner and became interested in more classes. I became aware of a program of study to become a certified Practitioner of Religious Science. I had previously taken several classes that fulfilled the prerequisites, so I could start the 2-year intensive program. The first term of Practitioner training was with Rev. Laura Hallett. My progress was put on hold first because of Rev. Laura leaving CSLSG and then because of the issues around COVID-19. A blessing from the Covid quarantine was the emergence of online Zoom meetings, which allowed me to join the Las Vegas CSL group, and my former teacher, Rev. Staci Hylton, to continue Practitioner training from the comfort of my home. I began the first year again and joined a wonderful group of students from Las Vegas, Ft. Lauderdale, and New York. Our class was dedicated, and Rev. Staci, with her helpful Practitioner team, inspired us the whole time. After much study and practice, this year I passed the final exam on June 25th and the oral panel exam on July 9th.

Becoming a Practitioner is time-consuming with weekly classes, assignments, reading, and papers to write. I have increased appreciation for anyone in our CSL communities who has RScP behind their name. The time and expense given to be a licensed Religious Science Practitioner is extensive.

I am privileged to join our wonderful group of Practitioners at CSLSG. Each has been educated and trained to be a spiritual counselor and is dedicated to serving our community. I have had several sessions with our Practitioners that were life-changing. They helped me see the spiritual truth of problems and resolve dilemmas I had carried for many years. 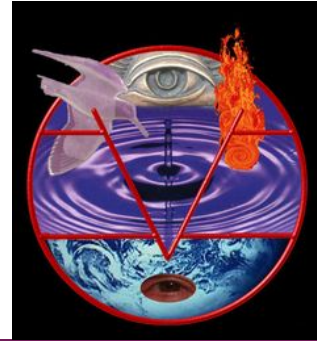

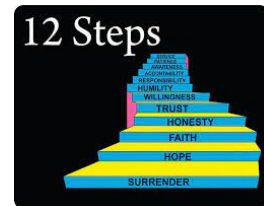
