giving gifts to show their love to one another. Love is such a wonderful feeling and energy, and for every person you ask to define “love,” you will end up with a unique answer. Because love may be described in many ways and can be seen as having many layers to it, it is easy to get caught up in the trivialness of the holiday’s expectations. I make it a practice to remind myself there is only Divine Love. I was about to write that Divine Love is given unconditionally to everyone equally, but this is not true! Wait, keep reading...

What is not true about the previous statement is that Divine Love is never “given”, because Love is all there is, therefore how can it be given!? In Religious Science, it is believed there is only one God/Creator/Source, and It created all that is known from Itself. Our founder, Ernest Holmes, describes Spirit’s domain as a circle whose circumference is infinite and whose center point is everywhere. In other words, all of God’s love is right where you are reading this (and everywhere else) in Its fullness. And if there is nothing “outside” of God’s circle, then clearly this means we each ARE the Love, the Divine Love, that we are seeking, that we are feeling, that we are discovering through our everyday living. 


